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# A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to provide for coverage under the Medicare program of pharmacist services.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3 **SECTION 1. MEDICARE COVERAGE OF PHARMACIST SERV-**  
4 **ICES.**

5 (a) COVERAGE.—Section 1861(s)(2) of the Social Se-  
6 curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1395x(s)(2)) is amended—

7 (1) by striking “and” at the end of subpara-  
8 graph (EE);

1           (2) by adding “and” at the end of subpara-  
2 graph (FF); and

3           (3) by inserting after subparagraph (FF) the  
4 following new subparagraph:

5           “(GG) pharmacist services furnished by a  
6 pharmacist, as licensed by State law, individ-  
7 ually or on behalf of a pharmacy provider—

8           “(i) which the pharmacist is legally  
9 authorized to perform in the State in  
10 which the individual performs such serv-  
11 ices;

12           “(ii) as would otherwise be covered  
13 under this part if furnished by a physician,  
14 or as an incident to a physician’s service;  
15 and

16           “(iii) in a setting located in a health  
17 professional shortage area (as defined in  
18 section 332(a)(1)(A) of the Public Health  
19 Service Act), medically underserved area,  
20 or medically underserved population (as  
21 defined in section 330(b)(3) of such Act);”.

22           (b) PAYMENT.—Section 1833(a)(1) of the Social Se-  
23 curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1395l(a)(1)) is amended—

24           (1) by striking “and (Z)” and inserting “(Z)”;

25           and

1           (2) by inserting before the semicolon at the end  
2           the following: “(AA) with respect to pharmacist  
3           services (as defined in section 1861(s)(2)(GG)), the  
4           amounts paid shall be equal to 80 percent of the  
5           lesser of the actual charge or 85 percent of the fee  
6           schedule amount provided under section 1848 if  
7           such services had been furnished by a physician”.

8           (c) EFFECTIVE DATE; PHARMACIST SPECIFIC  
9           CODES.—

10           (1) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made  
11           by subsections (a) and (b) shall apply with respect  
12           to services furnished on or after January 1, 2015.

13           (2) PHARMACIST SPECIFIC CODES.—The Sec-  
14           retary of Health and Human Services shall develop  
15           pharmacist specific codes, as necessary, under the  
16           physician fee schedule under section 1848 of the So-  
17           cial Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395w-4).
